AlarmDisk Description

AlarmDisk is a security tool that monitors the usage of detectable ATA devices. AlarmDisk will monitor and log device power cycles as well as device power-on hours. Log files are encrypted to prevent tampering. AlarmDisk alerts you to unauthorized use of your ATA storage device.

FEATURES:

- ✦ View Current ATA device Power-On-Hours and Power-Cycle Counts (POHC/PCC)
- ✦ View logged POHC and PCC for all previous devices
- ✦ Log files are encrypted to prevent tampering
- ✦ Alerts you when an ATA device has been externally powered
- ✦ Alerts when an ATA device has been powered on longer than last reported
- ✦ Supports PATA and SATA

AlarmDisk

AlarmDisk is an effective and affordable tool that alerts the user to tampering of ATA devices. AlarmDisk will alert you to the fact that a device has been powered on outside of Windows.

AlarmDisk alerts the user of the level of threat with an icon in the system tray, red indicating an incorrect power-cycle count on a device, yellow indicating all other warnings, and green for no warnings. You can view the history of alerts generated at anytime, even after an alert has been acknowledged so you can view alerts accepted by other users without your knowledge.

If your ATA device was cloned and replaced with the same model of device without your knowledge you will be alerted by a "SN# XXXXXXXX Device Not Present" warning. If an ATA device was removed from your system and then replaced, or your system was booted into a non Windows environment, you will be alerted by the Power-Cycle mismatch warning.
